USDA Nondiscrimination Statement on Websites and Materials

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As a result of a recent Civil Rights Review completed by USDA of the Delaware School Nutrition Programs we are issuing the following guidance:

- All School Food Authorities (SFA) who maintain websites must include the current USDA Nondiscrimination Statement (NDS) on the website
- Any information that is produced by the School Nutrition Program must include the current USDA NDS
  - This includes education materials, outreach materials, etc.
- The statement, when possible, needs to be used in its entirety
- And Justice for All posters need to be updated with the current version (we have a supply available)

## USDA Nondiscrimination Statement

**For all other FNS nutrition assistance programs, State or local agencies, and their subrecipients, must post the following Nondiscrimination Statement:**

## USDA Nondiscrimination Statement 2015 (Spanish Translation)

**For all other FNS nutrition assistance programs, State or local agencies, and their subrecipients, must post the following Nondiscrimination Statement:**

**Los demás programas de asistencia nutricional del FNS, las agencias estatales y locales, y sus beneficiarios secundarios, deben publicar el siguiente Aviso de No Discriminación:**

De conformidad con la Ley Federal de Derechos Civiles y los reglamentos y políticas de derechos civiles del Departamento de Agricultura de los EE. UU. (USDA, por sus siglas en inglés), se prohíbe que el USDA, sus agencias, oficinas, empleados e instituciones que participan o administran programas del USDA discriminen sobre la base de raza, color, nacionalidad, sexo, discapacidad, edad, o en represalia o venganza por actividades previas de derechos civiles en algún programa o actividad realizados o financiados por el USDA.
